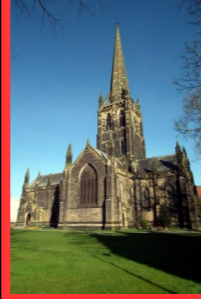

Design and Technology

We will be:

- Researching house types.
- Drawing and sketching a design of a house.
- Making a house.
- Evaluating our houses.



Science

As scientists we will be:

- Exploring the properties of materials to see which would be most suitable for a house
- Observing changes across the 4 seasons
- Describing weather associated with the seasons
- Looking at how day length varies throughout the seasons

Computing

In computing we will be:

- Comparing old and new buildings on Purple Mash
- Drawing our own house on Dazzle
- Designing a 3D house on Purple Mash
- Using Goole Earth to locate our own house



Geography

In Geography we will be:

- Locating where we live on a world map
- Exploring different types of houses around the world



Buildings

Entry Point

Children will be creating different buildings from around Goole using different resources including Lego, Duplo and junk modelling.

British Values

We will be exploring the types of buildings and houses that are in our surrounding areas. We will look at how houses in Britain have evolved throughout the years.



Music

As musicians we will be:

- Exploring the structure of music
- Composing a repetitive piece of music to perform to the rest of the class

Maths

As Mathematicians we will be:

- Focusing on place value to 20
- Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
- Say what is one more or one less than any number.
- Recognise and create repeating patterns with objects and with shapes.
- Recognise patterns in numbers, including odd and even numbers.
- Developing our knowledge and skills in Addition
- Developing our knowledge and skills in Subtraction
- Naming 2D and 3D shapes, and describing their properties

Cross curricular link

- Look at buildings and the different shapes we can find on them.
- Exploring temperature relating to the weather.

Physical Education

In indoor PE we will be:

- Focusing on interpretive dance
- Linking movements to changes in Music

In outdoor PE we will be:

- Focusing on Athletics
- Developing our throwing and catching skills

Religious Education

In RE we will be:

- Exploring religious symbols and artefacts that are important to specific religions
- Learning about religious celebrations and festivals
- Looking at Sikhism.
