Nursery will follow the Foundation Stage Curriculum. Nursery will follow the Foundation Stage Curriculum. During the Summer Term, we will be focusing on preparing children to enter Reception class, specifically focusing on developing their independence. We will learn about the town that we live in. We will begin to write letters.

Phonics

We will continue to develop our Phase 1 phonics skills. We will learn some Set 1 sounds and practise saying them. We will look at books and turn the pages.

We will learn to move safely in a space. We will learn to follow a path. We will develop control when using different equipment.

PSHCE (PSED)

We will learn to take turns. We will happily come into Nursery on a morning. We will hang our belongings up and take our coat on and off. We will use the toilet by ourselves. We will enjoy playing with our friends in different areas of the Unit.

Religious Education and Worldviews (UtW)

We will begin to be able to identify differences between ourselves and our friends. We will learn about some of the different countries around the world.

Computing

We will play interactive whiteboard games. We will explore direction and following instructions through games such as 'Simon Says'.

Science (UtW)

We will explore the natural world around us through hands on experiences. We will investigate different materials using our senses (touch, taste, smell, sight, hearing).

Geography (UtW)

We will learn some facts about Google and some of the landmarks in Google, (e.g. the salt and pepper pot, the clock tower). We will learn about some of the different countries around the world.

English (CL/L)

We will learn to listen to others in conversations. We will learn to follow one word level instructions. We will be able to retell a simple event from the past. We will start copying different letters. We will begin to have a go at writing our names. We will enjoy looking at books. We will use pictures to tell stories. We will learn to recognise our name.

History (UtW)

We will learn to talk about exciting events, (e.g. Birthdays, parties). We will talk about how we have changed over time and talk about some of these changes (e.g.

Art and DT (EAD)

We will draw pictures and explain what we have drawn. We will use the pencils and crayons in the classroom. We will use different construction materials to build different things. We will explore joining different materials together.

Maths (M)

We will be able to count up to 10. We will recognise numbers 1-3. We will learn to find one more and one less for numbers up to 3. We will compare different groups of things and say which has more or less. We will compare length, height, capacity and size.

Music (EAD)

We will sing and perform nursery rhymes. We will experiment with different instruments and the sounds that they make. We will create musical patterns using body percussion.
