

Reception Summer Term 2024

Reception will follow the Foundation Stage Curriculum. This term we will be working towards the Early Learning Goals. We will be focusing on supporting children with their reading and writing skills. We will consolidate our knowledge of numbers 1-10. Later in the term, we will be focusing on preparing the children to enter Year 1 and work to support them in their transition.

Phonics

We will be recapping Set 1 sounds and learning Set 2 sounds. We will practise applying our blending skills in longer words and sentences. We will practise reading and writing our red words.

PE (PD)

We will learn to move safely when playing tagging games. We will develop our accuracy when throwing and kicking and practise keeping score. We will work as part of a team.

PSHCE (PSED)

We will practise setting simple goals and reflect on our progress of achieving these goals. We will learn to follow instructions containing 3 steps. We will understand the importance of healthy food. We learn not to give up when things are difficult. We will have formed strong friendships.

Geography (UtW)

We will explore atlases and maps. We will look at where Goole is on a map. We will begin to understand some of the symbols used to represent things.

Art and DT (EAD)

We will share our creations, talk about process and evaluate our own work. We will explore mixing colours and creating secondary colours.

We will learn about <u>different artists</u> (e.g. Henri Matisse). We will practise creating observational drawings.

Religious Education and Worldviews (UtW)

We will talk about events in our lives and the lives of our family. We will explore similarities and differences between ourselves and others, and among families, communities and traditions.

Computing

We will use the class ipads to create pictures. We will practise programming Beebot to follow a simple path.

History (UtW)

We will be thinking about the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling. We will be able to talk about how some things have changed over time, and think about the similarities and differences.

Maths (M)

We will recognise numbers to 20. we will solve simple e number problems. We will know doubling acts to 10. We will find half of numbers up to 10.

We will use shapes to make patterns. We will finish a repeating pattern. We will be able to name and describe some 2D and 3D shapes.

Science (UtW)
