

#### Unit Objective:

To learn six colours in French and learn how to describe yourself as a superhero.

# By the end of this unit we will be able to:

- Recognise, recall, and remember the six colours presented in this unit in French.
- Recognise and remember the high frequency verbs 'I am called', 'I have', 'I live', 'I am' and 'I am able'.
- Present and describe ourselves as a superhero.

#### It will help if we already know:



• Vocabulary from the Greetings unit and the Colours & Numbers unit.

### Skills we will develop:

Learning to listen carefully and repeat what we hear with improving accuracy. Working on memory skills so we are able to remember the new words and phrases we have learnt in French long term and with accurate and authentic pronunciation.

## Activities we will complete:

A lot of tasks to help us learn to listen more carefully in French. Repeating the words and short phrases each lesson to ensure we can remember all the new words and language presented to us. Remembering and recalling more easily and with more confidence each lesson. Helping to improve our memory skills and linguistic competence.

# Grammar we will learn & revisit:

Nouns & articles/determiners. We will start to notice that in French there are often more options for single words like determiners than in English. For example, as seen with the word for 'a' in French; **un super-héro** but **une super-héroïne.** We will see that this happens a lot in French and learn why in future units!

#### Phonics & pronunciation we will see:



- ON nasal sound in Orion
- OU sound in rouge, Rouquette & courir
- **Guttural 'R'.** Becoming more familiar with the French 'r' sound as seen in **rouge** and **orange**. Beginning to notice that this sound is made from the back of the mouth, not the front. Different to the 'r' sound in English!

Even if we do not see these letters and sounds in the lessons often, we will hear these signature French sounds many times as they appear in key words in this unit.

## Vocabulary we will learn & revisit:

Revision of six common colours and how to present ourselves as a superhero in French using the high frequency verbs 'I am called', 'I have', 'I live', 'I am' and 'I am able'.
