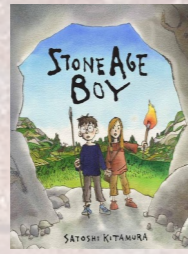


Shared and Guided Reading

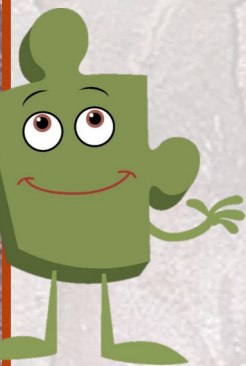
English

We will be:

- Completing the Place Value for Punctuation and Grammar unit to learn fundamental sentence structures.
- Writing poetry based on 'I Didn't Go Camping' by Kenn Nesbitt.
- Writing a non-chronological report on Stone Age animals.
- Writing a recount diary entry based on our shared reading text 'Stone Age Boy'

Maths (Including maths across the curriculum)

In Maths we will be learning to:

- Identify the value of digits in a 3-digit number.
- Compare and order numbers to 1000.
- Count in 4s, 8s, 50s and 100s.
- Add and subtract 3-digit numbers using the column method.
- Use estimation and inverse to solve number problems and check answers.

Physical Education

INDOOR PE - Fundamental Movements

- We will be learning a range of movement skills, including agility, balance and coordination,.

OUTDOOR PE - Multi Sports

- We will be learning to apply a range of skills to different sports and begin to apply strategies and tactics.

History

In History, we will be:

- Learning how fossils are formed and what we can learn from them.
- How our earliest ancestors might have lived.
- Learning about the migration of early humans.
- Learning how we can learn about the past by investigating a Stone Age Village.

Science

Through our 'Rocks and Soils' topic we will be finding out:

- The properties of different rocks.
- How rocks are formed and what they are.
- What soil is.
- How fossils are formed.
- Classifying rocks based on their appearance.
- What rocks can be used for.

We will be exploring Britain's dominant faith, Christianity, in RE lessons.



Geography

We will be learning about:

- The historical region of Mesopotamia
- Ancient Mesopotamian farming and how they were self-sufficient

RE - Remembering

We will be exploring the meaning of remembrance for different faiths including Christianity, Hinduism, Islam and atheism.

We will explore how these faiths celebrate key events through religious festivals and rituals.
